Dear Parishioners & Visitors,

Of all the images we have of Jesus, one of the loveliest is that of the Good Shepherd, and so the Fourth Sunday of Easter is dedicated to this theme because in each of the three lectionary cycles, the Gospel reading invites us to reflect on Jesus as the Good Shepherd. In each cycle the reading is from the tenth chapter of John's Gospel. This chapter sets the framework for Jesus' teaching about himself as the Good Shepherd.

Today's reading falls between the stories of Jesus' healing of the man born blind and the raising of Lazarus. Following the controversy that ensued when Jesus healed the man born blind. Jesus directs his allegory about the sheep and the shepherd toward the Jewish religious leaders of his time, the Pharisees. And so, in this gospel from John, Jesus tells us: "I am a good shepherd: the good shepherd is the one who lays down his life for his sheep... I know my own, and my own knows me...they listen to my voice..." From this passage we can learn the part each party plays.

The good shepherd knows and takes care of his flock. He is patient, he loves and never harms his own flock. A good shepherd is readily available for his flock. He is ready to make sacrifices for their good. On the other hand, a good flock listens to its shepherd. It obeys his instructions and follows him with trust and confidence. This means that the relationship between the sheep and their shepherd is based on familiarity. Sheep recognize their shepherd and will not follow a stranger. At the end of the day, shepherds lead their sheep from pastures to a common gated area called a sheepfold.

Today's Gospel also gives us the opportunity to reflect on Christian leadership. Jesus' words suggest to us that those who will lead the Christian community will be known by their faithfulness to Jesus. The leaders will recognize that Jesus is the gate for all the sheep and that having a good relationship with Jesus is the primary characteristic of a Christian leader. Jesus' allegory also suggests that faithful Christian leadership requires a good relationship with the community.

The celebration of Christ the Good Shepherd today reminds us that we are shepherds, as well as flocks. This is because each one of us is occupying one leadership position or the other. So, who is a good shepherd and where can we find one? We can find a good shepherd, in every good mother or father, in an honest president or governor, in a holy and caring priest. We can find a good Shepherd in every humble and God-fearing youth, in a caring brother or sister, and in every just and respectful police officer. Where there is a caring doctor, a dedicated teacher, a good cook, cleaner or gardener, there is a good shepherd.

The church in her wisdom provides us another good opportunity to pray for the Holy Father, all the leaders of the church, families and the world. With our hope and confidence strongly placed in the risen Christ let us pray: "The Lord is my Shepherd there is nothing I shall want" (Ps 23). Alleluia, Alleluia.
